Discussion Questions:

1. Name five of the main problems common to all humanity that require global cooperation.
2. Name five problems that are avoidable but also common that distract humanity from cooperation.
3. Davidge and Jerry memorize each other's ancestry, what does that symbolize in terms of how cooperation is discovered.
4. Read Acts 2:1-12 (The story of Pentecost) What does this say about the work of the Holy Spirit and how does this relate to the movie Enemy Mine?
5. Read Romans 8:12-17 How does this relate to the movie? And what does it say about how the church should behave?
